



#### **ACTIVITIES**

PRAYER :

As it is a teachers training institute all the trainees attend prayer class which is mandatory.

Teory Class:

A Student must secure 80% of attendance in theory classes otherwise he will not be eligible to fill up the forms for examination.

#### Internship Programme: For B. Ed. trainees the internship programme helds in two ....:

- a) Observation one month (1st Year)
- b) Practice Teaching Three months (2nd Year) They have to deliver 60 lessons in Schools. As per rule they have to secure 90% of attendance in practicals.

For B.El. Ed. Trainees they are to go for practice teaching 30 days in 1st yer & 30 days in 2nd Yr. The purpose is to make them fit for 'What to leach & how to teach'. They shall learn the methods, techniques, processes and ways of teaching.

Projects:

The students are assigned with some project works which are related to environment & community development.

Art & Craft work: They perform some art & craft work to enhance their skills and abilities.

Seminars:

The internal seminars are held on covering current topics & text books to activities the knowledge & participation of the students. It is conducted in regular intervals.

Cultural activities: This is also a major part of activities to make the students more socialised, co-

operative, creative ect. Every year the National Days (Republic Day, Independence Day, teachers, Day, etc.), International Days (World Environment World Health Day, International literacy Day), State Days (Robindra Jayanti, Netaji Jayanti, etc.) are observed along with some Basanta Utsav, Saraswati Juja, Agamony Utsav etc. The



institute helds Annual Function and awards the deserved meritorius students in different fields.

Competitions:

The Institute organises debate, Quiz, Music, Sports Competitions to encourage the students to use their intrinsic qualities.



Admission:

The Students take admission on the basis of their merit. As per forms they have secure 50% of marks in its & Graduation. The rules of the state Govt. is followed accordingly, regarding the fees collected, it is as per the instruction of the University & Board. The NCTE has approved 100 seats each for B. Ed & D.El. Ed. Courses.

Examination: The Students appear internal test examinations every year to know their

performance. They become aware of their strength & weaknesses. The teachers guide then accordingly During two years in B. Ed. they are to appear in 04 (four) semister examinations conducted by the Board. The college has been selected by the University and board as one of the
